



# THE GLOBAL STATUS OF CCS: 2015

*The Global Status of CCS: 2015* is the Institute's annual publication on the progress of carbon capture and storage (CCS) globally.

Up to 28 million tonnes of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions will be captured by existing operational carbon capture and storage projects this year, according to this new report.

Now in its sixth year, *the Global Status of CCS 2015* profiles two large-scale CCS projects that became operational in 2015 – the Canadian Quest project and the Uthmaniyah CO<sub>2</sub>-EOR Demonstration Project in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Uthmaniyah is the first large-scale CCS project in the Middle East.
