



## THE GLOBAL STATUS OF CCS: 2015

The Global Status of CCS: 2015 is the Institute's annual publication on the progress of carbon capture and storage (CCS) globally.

Up to 28 million tonnes of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions will be captured by existing operational carbon capture and storage projects this year, according to this new report.

Now in its sixth year, the Global Status of CCS 2015 profiles two large-scale CCS projects that became operational in 2015 – the Canadian Quest project and the Uthmaniyah  ${\rm CO_2}$ -EOR Demonstration Project in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Uthmaniyah is the first large-scale CCS project in the Middle East.
